Status	Guideline Criteria (any of)	Key Restrictions
<b>RED</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 6+ positive cases at one time (staff, students, fellows)</li> <li>• &gt;250 students in College rooms (half) in SI at one time</li> <li>• 2/3 of key teams in SI (Catering, HK, Porters)</li> <li>• Significant adverse change in national guidelines</li> </ul>	<p>As Amber, plus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Takeaway food only – very limited menu, focus on food delivery to those in self-isolation (SI)</li> <li>• All teaching online</li> <li>• All staff work from home who can; minimum operational staff on site</li> <li>• Strong recommendation to students not to go into town for social reasons</li> <li>• Gates closed; absolutely essential visitors to College only</li> <li>• Consider introducing distancing within Households</li> <li>• Close JCR/MCR, Library (online), Bar (or reduce hours). Consider Chapel</li> </ul>
<b>AMBER</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Default from start of FPR to 3 weeks into Full Term</li> </ul> <p>At other times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3+ positive cases at one time</li> <li>• &gt;100 students in College rooms in SI at one time</li> <li>• 1/3 of key teams in SI</li> </ul>	<p>As set out in Design in September Council paper and Protocols. Key features:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lectures online, small group teaching in person</li> <li>• Social distancing and face coverings policy. Students not required to follow when in their own households (which are maximum size of 11)</li> <li>• Households may visit one another in daytime in line with 'rule of 6'</li> <li>• No overnight visitors to household in student rooms</li> <li>• Sit down dining and Bar open</li> <li>• Authorised visitors only; gates closed except main gate during the day</li> <li>• Library, Chapel, JCR and MCR open, but Gym closed</li> </ul>
<b>YELLOW</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Possible from week 4 to end of MT, provided Amber or Red criteria not met</li> </ul> <p>Subsequently:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1-2 positive cases at one time</li> <li>• &gt;50 students in College rooms in SI at one time</li> </ul>	<p>As Amber except:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Consider merging Households to create larger groups up to 15</li> <li>• Served dining restarts, including Formal Hall/High Table</li> <li>• Visitors allowed for social purposes, e.g. dining or to bar</li> <li>• Aim to re-open Gym</li> </ul>
<b>GREEN</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Likely only possible from a few weeks into Lent Term</li> <li>• No positive cases</li> <li>• &lt;50 SI students in College accommodation at one time</li> </ul>	<p>As Yellow except:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Consider relaxing distancing and face covering requirements, subject to government and public health guidance</li> <li>• Consider merging more households to create larger groups up to 25</li> <li>• Overnight guests allowed in student rooms, with permission of Tutor and all members of household</li> </ul>
